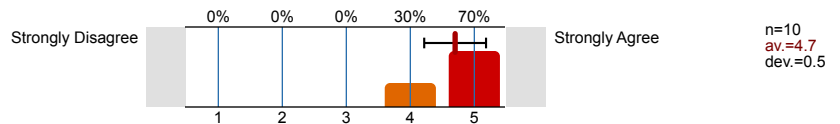
3.1) WILLIAM JIMENEZ SENZANO presented the course material clearly.
